The DFF – Deutsches Filminstitut & Filmmuseum



The DFF – Deutsches Filminstitut & Filmmuseum is accessible for visitors with limited mobility and for guests with wheelchairs via a elevator at the right-side entrance of the museum. Elevators in the foyer provide barrier-free access to all exhibition floors (1st to 3rd floor), the cinema on the ground floor and the film workshop and workshop rooms on the 4th floor. A separate disabled restroom is located on the ground floor. The house also provides a wheelchair for rent.

FilmBühne Caligari

The Caligari offers a largely barrier-free cinema experience. The box office, foyer, bar, cinema auditorium and disabled restrooms are on the ground floor. Films with audio description and soundtrack for deaf people can be heard individually through the in-house hearing system. Headphones and radio loops can be borrowed free of charge at the box office upon presentation of an identification document.
